## Winter is coming—Stay on your Feet

Every year, slips and falls cause thousands of preventable injuries on job sites—especially during Michigan's icy months. Most happen during routine activities: stepping out of a truck, carrying materials, or walking to the trailer.



- ✓ Watch for **black ice** black ice in parking lots, walkways, and around trailers.
- ✓ Keep **three points of contact** when entering or exiting vehicles or equipment.
- ✓ Wear **boots with proper traction**.
- ✓ Clear and treat walkways early. **Don't wait until someone slips.**
- ✓ Slow down and take shorter steps on icy or wet surfaces

OSHA and MIOSHA require that walking-working surfaces be kept clean, dry, and free of hazards where possible (**OSHA 29 CFR 1910.22**). Everyone plays a part in identifying and reporting icy or slick areas.

# BCI Wins 2025 Excellence in Construction Award!


## Corewell Health – HDVCH Hematology Oncology Clinic 2nd Floor Renovation
