SITE SAFETY – BECAUSE WE Working Safe in the Summer Heat

It's been a hot one in Michigan!! Whether you're on a rooftop, in a bucket, or working ground level, summer heat can wear you down fast if you're not prepared. Working smart in the heat isn't just about comfort, it's about staying safe, staying sharp, and looking out for your crew.

Work Smarter, Not Harder

- Plan heavier tasks early in the day when it's cooler.
- Rotate physically demanding jobs when possible.
- Watch for crew mates.

Hydration

- Drink water before you're thirsty and aim for 1 cup every 15–20 minutes.
- Skip energy drinks and pop since they can speed up dehydration.

Sunscreen and Skin Protection

- Use SPF 30+ and reapply every 2 hours or more often if you're sweating.
- Wear a hat, sunglasses, and lightweight long sleeves for extra protection.

Hot Tools & Surfaces

- Wear gloves to handle tools, equipment, and surfaces that have been sitting in the sun to avoid burns.
- Cover tools in the shade when not in use.

Heat Fatigue & Overexertion

- Watch for dizziness, nausea, confusion, or excessive sweating.
- Take breaks in the shade or cool spot when needed.
- Speak up and never ignore symptoms of heat related illness.

On Track for an August Completion



BCI is nearing completion on a 30,000-SF, 2-phase renovation and expansion of New Hope Community Church, with work on track to wrap up in August. As Design-Builder, BCI combined wood framing with PEMB steel erection to deliver a more functional and welcoming space while the church remained fully operational. Highlights include an expanded lobby, remodeled KidZone, new gymnasium, flexible meeting rooms, sanctuary upgrades, office expansion, a relocated kitchen, modern restrooms, and added storage.
